



Evangelist Reinhard Bonnke

Christ for all Nations (CfaN) founder and lead Evangelist Reinhard Bonnke is best known for his Gospel crusades throughout Africa. Thirty-nine years ago, Evangelist Bonnke founded the international ministry of CfaN, which currently has offices in the United States, Canada, Germany, United Kingdom, Nigeria, South Africa, Singapore, Australia, Hong Kong and Brazil.

Evangelist Bonnke is recognized for his burning passion for the Gospel, a vision for Africa and a message for the world. Since the start of the new millennium, through a host of major events in Africa and other parts of the world, the ministry has recorded more than 72 million documented decisions for Jesus Christ.



The son of a pastor, Evangelist Bonnke gave his life to the Lord at age nine, and heard the call to the African mission field before he was a teenager. After attending Bible College in Wales and becoming ordained in Germany, he pastored a church before started missionary work in Africa. There he held tent meetings, accommodating only 800 people. As attendance steadily increased, larger and larger tents had to be purchased. Soon, attendance at Evangelist Bonnke's meetings exceeded the capacity of a tented structure and he began open-air Gospel campaigns with an initial gathering of over 150,000 people per service. Since then, Evangelist Bonnke has conducted city-wide meetings across Africa with as many as 1.6 million people attending a single meeting.

As a result of his work in Africa, over 200 million copies of CfaN literature have been published in 104 languages and printed in 55 countries. In addition, the Reinhard Bonnke School of Fire, an online, self-study course, aimed at inspiring others to evangelism, has also been founded, and Evangelist Bonnke has conducted "Fire Conferences" in many different countries around the world, to equip church leaders and workers for evangelism.

Evangelist Bonnke has had great success through God in Africa and across the world. Recently, Evangelist Bonnke heard from God that because of those who have giving heart to the nations, America will now receive a harvest of souls just as Africa has experienced with commitments from millions of people who now live dedicated to Jesus Christ. As a result of his God given vision, Bonnke is taking his efforts to the United States by launching a U.S. crusade tour called "Good News: a Gospel Crusade with International Evangelist Reinhard Bonnke," a series of events inspiring Americans to draw nearer to a relationship with Jesus through the Holy Spirit. God approached Bonnke with the city-to-city tour idea, telling him to start crusades in America because the county needs salvation. The first crusade will take place in Orlando, Fla., at the Wells Fargo arena on September 27th and 28th, 2013.

Evangelist Bonnke is married to Anni, father to Kai-Uwe, Gabrielle, and Susie, and grandfather to eight grandchildren.
