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### **HONEYWELL SELECTS 70 TEACHERS FROM TEN COUNTRIES FOR GREEN BOOT CAMP**

#### ***Workshop Provides Teachers with New Ideas and Tools to Teach Energy and Sustainability to Middle School Students***

MINNEAPOLIS, May 22, 2013 – Honeywell (NYSE: HON) today announced its selection of 70 middle school teachers from ten countries to receive scholarships to [Green Boot Camp](#), a five-day interactive workshop focused on best practices for teaching energy, sustainability and environmental concepts. This year, the camp will welcome teachers from the United States, Australia, Canada, China, England, Hungary, India, Mexico, Nigeria and Scotland.

The workshop will take place June 24-28 in San Diego, Calif. at the SDG&E Energy Innovation Center, a Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design ([LEED](#)) Platinum certified facility, and the Bayside Community Center.

During the week, the teachers will participate in hands-on workshops to build rain barrels and wind turbines, and gain information on energy efficiency, renewable energy technologies, and calculating greenhouse gas emissions to enhance their curricula. The week also will feature a guided tour of historic Balboa Park to learn how sustainability practices are shaping park facilities
