



## ABOUT BEAN

Born Noelle Bean on August 26, 1991, Bean was raised in Nashville and, for the past six years, she has made her home in the Dallas-Fort Worth area. She writes her own music, personally describing it as “mainstream pop with a bit of the old 50s and 60s retro vibe.”

Bean was recently a part of the Macy’s/iHeart Radio Rising Star Campaign which featured the top 25 Indie acts across the country. She was also named one of the Top 5 Indie Acts of 2013, and Teen.com wrote Bean is “basically everything we look for in a new artist...that totally reminds us of a mix between Adele and Amy Winehouse.”

Although Bean is just 22 years old, she has gone through a lot in her life. Through her songs, Bean aims to connect with fans that are living the joys, sorrows and dreams that everyone faces. Bean is especially passionate about empowering young people to embrace who they are, find their inner-confidence, and reach their full-potential which she does through her song-writing and her connections with her fan community.

*Cops and Robbers* is Bean’s first single, it was featured on iHeart Radio and is currently being spun on Sirius 20on20, 98.5 KLUC#1 Pop Station in Vegas and several other stations across the country. Bean’s song *Let’s Go* will also be featured in the 2014 Mitsubishi Mirage Car Commercial set to launch at the end of Q4 into 2014.

Bean said “having my first ever EP on iTunes is a milestone for my short career thus far, I feel like I can breathe.”

Bean has performed live in front of enthusiastic international crowds including a concert with Hot Chelle Rae and Megan & Liz at B.B. King Blues Club & Grill in New York City. She also performed three “standing room only” shows at The Living Room & Rockwood in New York City and most recently the Seventeen Magazine and Camille La Vie Promazing Event. Bean performed in Austin at SXSW and Florida Music Festival 2013 (3 shows each); the

House of Blues in both Dallas and Chicago; The Roxy in Los Angeles; Yellowphone Music Conference in Milwaukee; NASCAR - Miami; The Dallas 2012 Children's Medical Holiday Parade to 350,000 people; and internationally at a May 2012 concert at the Monaco Grand Prix where she sang in front of Prince Albert of Monaco.

Bean's passion for writing and performing is apparent in everything she does. "You only live once and I get to do what I love," Bean said in a recent interview. "I hope the world loves my music as much as I do writing it."
