Your design must be between 8.5" x 11" and 11" x 17"

Your design must include both Americans for the Arts and The Art Institutes logos, which can be downloaded at artinstitutes.edu/postercompetition.

COLOR AND TYPOGRAPHY:

Think about how the use of color and typefaces can impact your design.
