



Questions to Ask Your Treatment Team

For those newly diagnosed with advanced
Medullary Thyroid Cancer (aMTC)

FACING A DIAGNOSIS OF THYROID CANCER CAN BE TERRIFYING FOR ANYONE.

That fear can be compounded when the diagnosis is **advanced medullary thyroid cancer (aMTC)**—a type of thyroid cancer that has spread to lymph nodes, nearby tissue, or other parts of the body.

At first, you may feel confused or isolated.

IT'S IMPORTANT TO SHARE THESE EMOTIONS WITH LOVED ONES. As you navigate appointments with your treatment team and make decisions about your care, **you may find it helpful to ask questions** about your health and the impact treatments may have on your daily life. You shouldn't feel embarrassed to ask questions about what is important to you, or to reach out for clarifications if you have difficulty understanding the answers.
