The *Air National Guard Mobile Experience* takes you on a journey through life in the Air National Guard and features a series of three challenges, each simulating real-life roles and skills sets of Air Guard men and women. In addition to the challenges, you will visit an interactive uniform experience. The *Air National Guard Mobile Experience* includes:

- o **Basic Military Training (BMT)** you will demonstrate your physical strength with the pull-up bar challenge,
- **Technical training** you will have the ability to customize your journey by participating in a challenge matching a career field of your interest
 - o A small arms weapon M-9 Challenge
 - o Tactical Air Control Party (TACP) Airstrike Challenge
 - o Aircraft Maintenance Challenge
 - Medical Challenge
- Uniform experience you can digitally view yourself wearing the Air Guard uniform from your chosen career field
- Drill weekend you will hone your surveillance skills with a reconnaissance challenge which replicates a real mission Air Guardsmen could execute on drill weekend.

About Basic Military Training: In order for trainees in the Air National Guard to graduate BMT, they must meet or exceed the Air Force Fitness standard by successfully achieving a composite score greater than 75 and meet all minimum component areas.

About technical training: In the Air National Guard, you train with the most elite professionals in your field. Your training in the Air National Guard can carry over into a civilian career, and you'll be ahead of the pack in terms of knowledge, skills and abilities. Each career in the Air National Guard has specific training schools to make sure members have the resources and tools to meet their goals.

About drill weekend: In the Air National Guard, men and women have the opportunity to serve their country part time while maintaining a fulfilling civilian life, serving one weekend a month and two weeks a year close to home. Guardsmen serve on a variety of important missions, statewide in their communities as well as globally in support of our nation's homeland defense efforts.
