Overview of the Wicked Cyclone:

- **Wicked Cyclone** is the largest capital investment for Six Flags New England since 2002. Over 95% of the attraction and its materials were proudly made in the U.S.A.
- **Wicked Cyclone's** steel track provides riders with a smoother, faster and more intense ride along its 3,320 feet of track.
- The ride stands 10 stories in the sky and reaches speeds of up to 55 mph. Once the twenty-four thrill seekers board **Wicked Cyclone**, it quickly climbs the 109-foot hill to then plummet at maximum speeds while providing riders with weightlessness and a truly wicked ride.
- **Wicked Cyclone** will be the first coaster of its kind to have a hang-time inversion and two Zero-G Rolls. Riders will also be able to experience more airtime than any other coaster on the East Coast with 14 airtime hills on **Wicked Cyclone**.
