CRAFT ZONE

FOR LAWN HEALTH

All that running and sliding into home can cause overuse on the turf. Avoid excess play if the ground is saturated. If played frequently, move the play site to avoid soil compaction. Keep an eye on those spots anu make note to potentially aerate and re-seed this fall.

OUTDOOR FORT ZONE

FOR EXTRA FUN: Add outdoor blankets and pillows to mak this a comfortable place for lounging and imaginative play like cloud watching.

FOR LAWN HEALTH: Make sure to take down awnings or lawn coverings periodically so that this area can still get sunlight.





REFRESHMENT ZONE

Pack a cooler with refreshments to prevent the
neighborhood from tracking dirt into the house. Keep
a bucket handy filled with supplies the family might
need often: sunscreen, insect repellent, towels, etc.
