

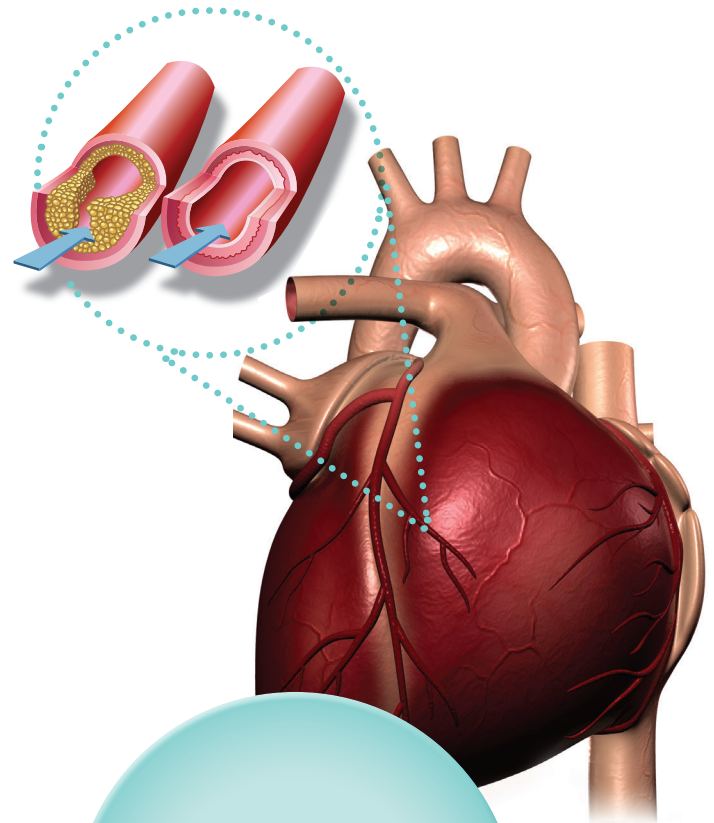
# WHAT IS CORONARY ARTERY DISEASE?

Coronary artery disease (CAD), the most common type of heart disease, is a condition in which the arteries that supply blood to the heart become narrowed or blocked by a build-up of “plaque” (fatty deposits).

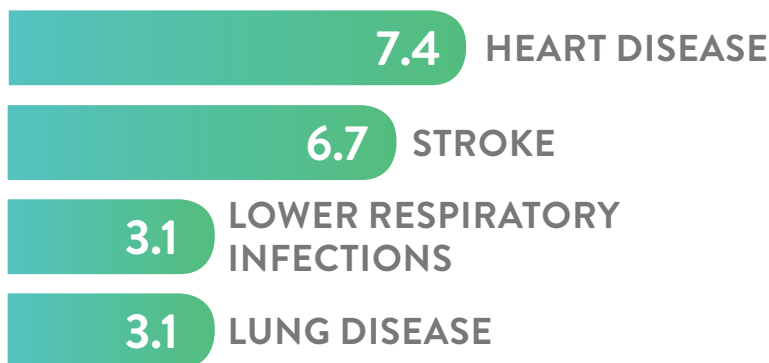
## COMMON SIGNS & SYMPTOMS:

- > Chest pain
- > Shortness of breath
- > Pain in jaw or arms
- > Heartburn
- > Nausea
- > Vomiting
- > Heavy sweating
