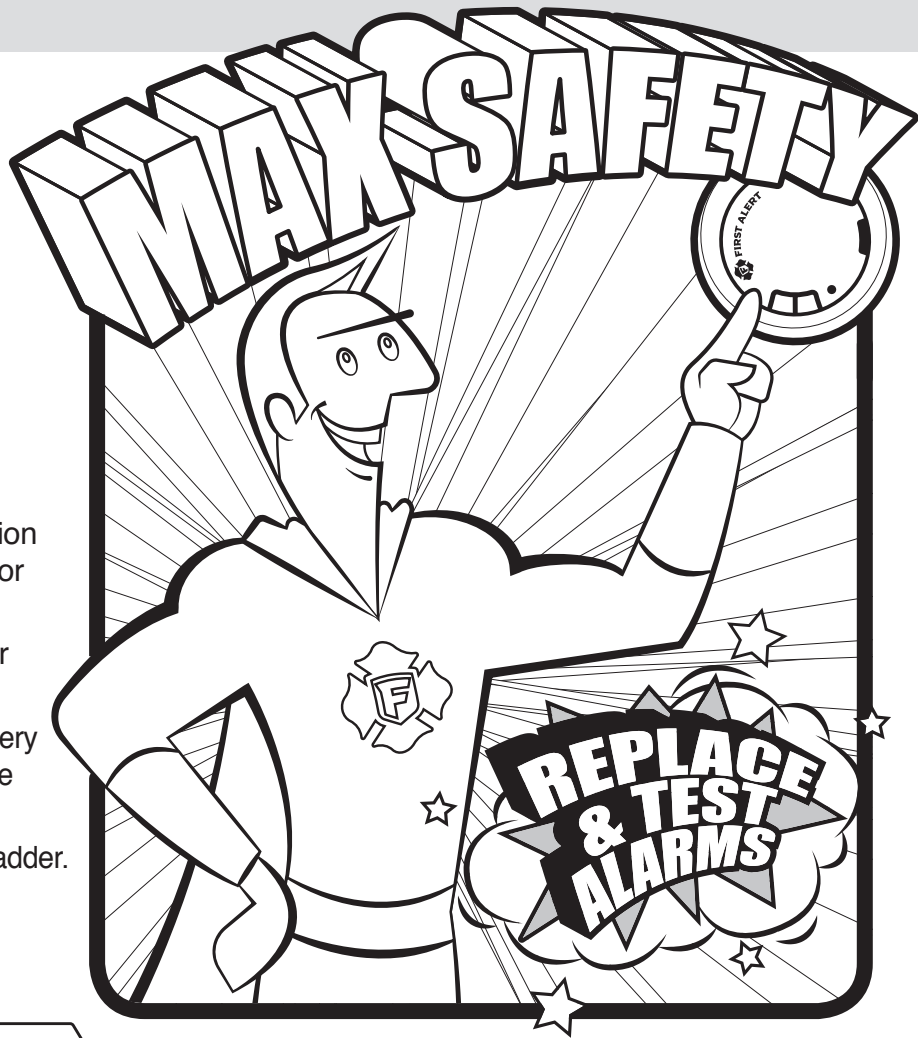

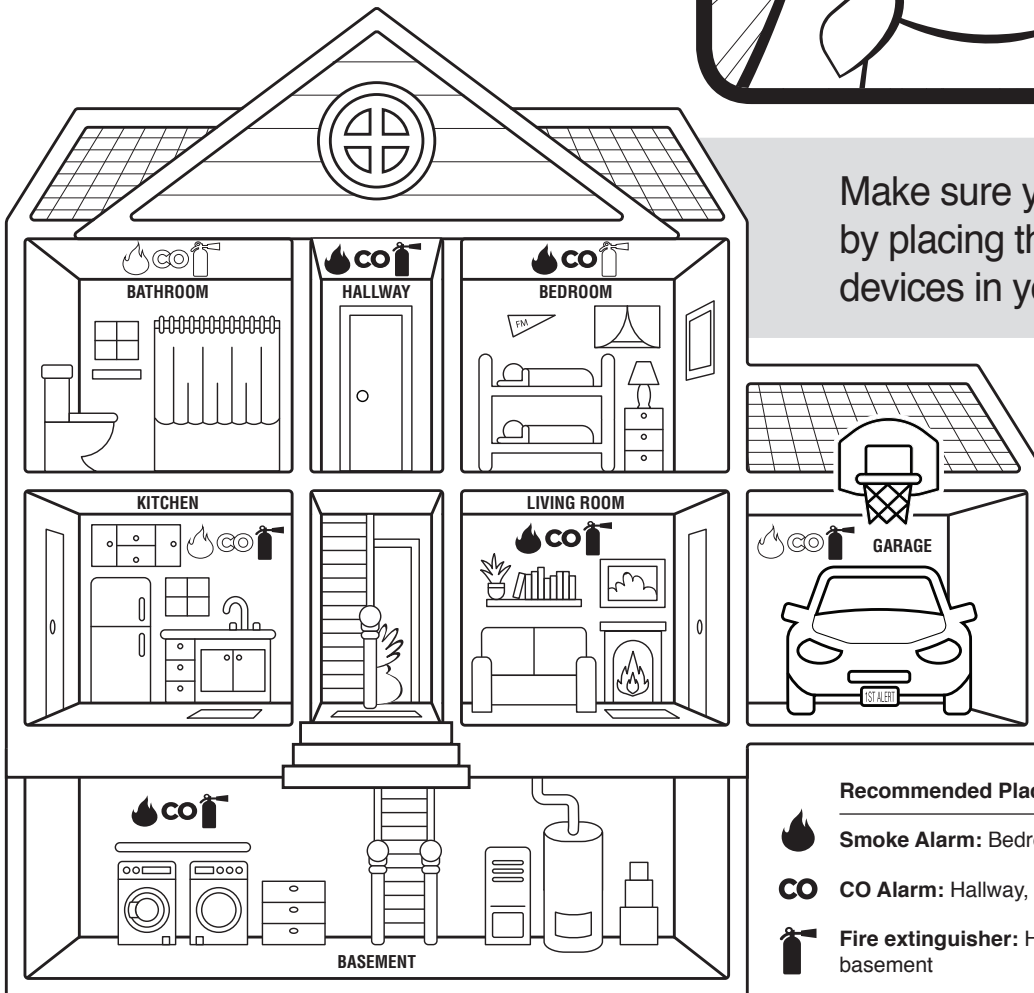
Super Safety Tips

- The NFPA recommends installing both ionization and photoelectric smoke alarms in the home for maximum protection.
- Install smoke alarms 10 feet away from major appliances.
- Install smoke and carbon monoxide alarms on every level and in every bedroom. Fire Extinguishers are also recommended on every level of your home.
- If you have a multi-story home, have an escape ladder.
