



**Dr. Peter Goadsby, M.D., PhD, MBBS**

*Neurologist and Headache Specialist, Professor at King's College London and University of California, Los Angeles*

Dr. Peter Goadsby is a neurologist who specializes in diagnosing and treating headache disorders, including migraine, cluster headache, and other forms of disabling headache. He is one of the world's leading headache experts and researchers and recently earned the prestigious Brain Prize in 2021 for his revolutionary research about CGRP's role in migraine attacks. Dr. Goadsby co-authored the AbbVie ADVANCE study.

Dr. Goadsby earned his medical degree at the University of New South Wales, Sydney. He then completed a residency in neurology at the Prince of Wales Hospital and a fellowship in neurology at the National Hospital for Nervous and Mental Diseases in London. He completed his postdoctoral work at laboratories in London, New York, and Paris.

Dr. Goadsby's research focuses on the mechanisms and management of head pain. His special interests are in migraine and trigeminal autonomic cephalalgia, a type of headache disorder in which pain and associated symptoms appear on one side of the head. His studies aim to investigate parts of the brain involved in headache and to derive new treatment approaches from this better understanding.
