Pamela T. Miller was also Deputy Commissioner, Environmental Health for the New York City Department of Health; Director of the Hudson County Department of Environmental and Public Health; and National Director for Occupational Health and Minority Initiatives for the American Lung Association.

Miller serves on the boards of Saint Peter's College, the Women's Board of the New Jersey Performing Arts Center, the New Jersey Public Policy Research Institute, and is a past president of the Garden State Bar Association. In 2006, she was nominated to serve as Commissioner of the New Jersey State Sports and Exposition Authority by former governor Jon S. Corzine, who also appointed Miller to serve on his Blue Ribbon Steering Committee for Financial Restructuring and Debt Reduction. Miller also is co-founder of the African-American Coalition on Diversity, a non-partisan policy think-tank.

In 2008, Miller was honored by the Meadowlands Chamber of Commerce for her business excellence and commitment to economic vitality. She was also honored by the Garden State Bar Association in 2007 with its highest award for professional achievement and community involvement. In 2005, she earned the Thurgood Marshall College Fund Award for Excellence, National Bar Association Award for Outstanding Service, and the Bergen County Black History Award for Professional Achievement.

Miller is a frequent speaker on health care policy issues and on corporate social responsibility.

Miller holds a bachelor's degree in natural science from Saint Peter's College and a master's degree in public administration from New York University. Miller earned her law degree from Seton Hall University School of Law and is admitted to practice in New Jersey and to the U.S. Supreme Court.
