History and Culture

Experience a taste of authentic Florida culture and history within the historic downtown districts of Kissimmee and St. Cloud, or take a stroll down the trendy, brick-lined streets of Celebration. A variety of local museums provide hands-on, educational fun. Pay your respects to Veterans at the Museum of Military History; take a step back in time at Warbird Adventures and Air Museum. Also visit the Welcome Center and History Museum for a look at the area's past. Before it was a dream vacation destination, Kissimmee was a town where Cracker Cowboys tended to herds of cattle on large ranches. Through that cowboy heritage grew the largest rodeo east of the Mississippi River, the annual Silver Spurs Rodeo. The twice-yearly rodeo is a longtime favorite for locals and visitors alike.

First-Class Entertainment

Concerts, sporting events, dinner shows, theatrical performances and live music are all offered in Kissimmee. The Silver Spurs Arena at Osceola Heritage Park (OHP) hosts a variety of entertainment acts from headliners and comedy shows to championship sports tournaments and equestrian events. OHP also hosts exciting professional and amateur sporting events throughout year. Catch a game of baseball during spring training at nearby Osceola County Stadium, home of the Houston Astros or ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex, home to the Atlanta Braves. For more excitement, enjoy a dinner show where visitors can cheer for their favorite knight at Medieval Times Dinner & Tournament, take in the speakeasy sounds and sights at Capone's Dinner and Show.
