Open House at NV Energy's Tracy Generating Station

What: NV Energy is hosting an open house near the Tracy Generating Station to highlight important projects completed at the plant site, including a portion of the Tahoe-Pyramid Bikeway and The Nature Conservancy's Truckee River Restoration Project.

When: Sunday, Oct. 5, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Where: The Tracy Generating Station, located 17 miles east of Reno-Sparks along I-80 East. The event will be near the river at the northwest corner of the plant site.

Who: Representatives from NV Energy will be at the event, along with representatives from the Tahoe-Pyramid Bikeway and The Nature Conservancy.

Visuals: Walking tours of the Truckee River Restoration project, cyclists on the Tahoe-Pyramid Bikeway, various NV Energy displays.

Directions: To reach the open house from Reno, take I-80 East to the USA Parkway exit about a mile east of the power plant. Take the first left off USA Parkway, turn right at the stop sign, and follow the signs to the parking area.
