

# 2014 Alzheimer's Disease Facts and Figures

In 2013, **15.5 million caregivers** provided an estimated **17.7 billion hours** of unpaid care valued at more than **\$220 billion.**

Deaths from Alzheimer's disease increased **68 percent** between 2000 and 2010.

In 2014, *Alzheimer's will cost* the nation **\$214 billion.** This number is expected to rise to **\$1.2 trillion** by 2050.

Nearly **19 percent** of women Alzheimer's caregivers had to quit work either to become a caregiver or because their caregiving duties became too burdensome.

More than **60 percent** of Alzheimer's and dementia caregivers are women.

Nearly **60 percent** of Alzheimer's and dementia caregivers rate the emotional stress of caregiving as high or very high, and more than one-third report symptoms of depression.

Due to the physical and emotional burden of caregiving, Alzheimer's and dementia caregivers had **\$9.3 billion** in additional health care costs of their own in 2013.
