With so many children living in poverty, kids across the country struggle because they can't get to the doctor. Preschoolers suffer with untreated earaches. Elementary school kids have trouble seeing the blackboard without glasses. Middle school kids fall asleep in class because of a restless night spent wheezing with asthma. Without needed medicine, high school students are often out sick. At every level, many kids don't have the chance to do their best in school.

Recognizing the many barriers that keep these disadvantaged kids from the doctors they need, Paul Simon and Dr. Irwin Redlener, pioneered an innovative solution 25 years ago – the first "medical clinic on wheels".

Today, Children's Health Fund's fleet of 50 medical mobile clinics brings health care to sick children in dozens of rural areas and disadvantaged urban neighborhoods nationwide. These clinics offer low-income families a better alternative than the emergency room.
