

ARIE LUYENDYK JR.





For 2016, and as part of the Lucas Oil Off-Road Race Series, Hostile Wheels has partnered with Arie Luyendyk Jr. for a third year sponsorship to showcase the durability from the often aggressive abuse wheels can take on in a challenging off-road series like within TORC: The Off-Road Championship Series.

Son of 2-time Indianapolis 500 winner Arie Luyendyk (1990 and 1997), Arie Jr. finished second in the Firestone Indy Lights Championship in 2002, third in 2004, and fourth in 2008. In 2013, he made the transition to off-road and started competing in Stadium Super Trucks series. In 2014, he made the podium at two out of three stops he competed in (a 3rd and 2nd in Indianapolis). This former runner-up on season eight of the Bachelorette is also currently contesting the TORC Pro 2 class. 32--year--old started Arie Jr.,competed in the Stadium Super Truck series in 2013, where he had two podium finishes in three starts. Arie was also the first funner--up in ABC's The Bachelorette in 2012.
